But as continued use of the technique has decimated both water quality and ecosystem health, it's coming under new scrutiny. A U.S. Geological Survey report released in late June suggests that mining done using current technologies may be responsible for degrading the nation's drinking water and soil. Currently, most of the 2 million tons of gravel dug annually in the U.S. is used for construction, roads, and landscaping. But that practice could be contributing to the problem, according to the report. Although modern methods of mining minimize the amount of pollutants released, emissions from gravel mining operations may be leaching harmful chemicals into streams and wetlands. Heavy metal pollution, in particular, can cause algae blooms, acidification of lakes, and make its way to wells, posing a threat to public health. The USGS suggests a number of policies to address the issue.
